Experience the Clay County Museum in a new and interactive way. As you visit the museum today you can learn more about 12 of our artifacts by using your cell phone.

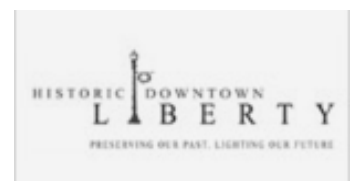
Look for the following logo next to an artifact:
